NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election will be held on **Tuesday, November 6, 2018** for the purpose of submitting for approval or rejection the following measure to be displayed on each individual ballot to wit:

the County Voter Information Guide. The examination period for the City Attorney’s Impartial Analysis of the Measure and arguments in favor of and against the Measure will be available for public review between **August 7 and August 17, 2018**.

Shall the ordinance which legalizes retail cannabis sales and commercial cannabis activity in certain zones, imposes operational requirements, and imposes an annual general tax of up to \$25 per square foot of space used for retail cannabis sales and up to \$3 per square foot for space used for other commercial cannabis activity (potentially generating \$196,875 annually from retail sales and an unknown amount from other commercial activity and continuing until repealed) be adopted? The elections official will provide opportunity for rebuttal arguments in accordance with Section 9285 of the Elections Code. Rebuttal arguments shall not exceed 250 words and must be filed with the City Clerk **no later than 5:00 p.m., August 17, 2018**.

A public exam period for rebuttals to arguments in favor of and against the Measure will be available from **August 18, 2018 to August 28, 2018**.
