COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The five-member committee shall meet on an as-needed basis to review applications for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding and provide the City Council with recommendations regarding the allocation of such funding.

Applicants must be Jurupa Valley residents. Applicants cannot be an employee of the City of Jurupa Valley. Applicants cannot serve in any capacity on any board, committee, or commission of any public agency or district. Applicants cannot have any decision-making authority in a community organization that applies for or receives funds through the CDBG program. The appointments are ratified by the City Council.

PLANNING COMMISSION

The five-member commission generally meets twice monthly to develop and review land use issues for the City of Jurupa Valley. The Planning Commission makes recommendations on these matters to the City Council. Members of the Planning Commission are appointed by the City Council. Each Council Member nominates one member of the Planning Commission, which requires ratification by a majority of the City Council.

Each of the five commissioners shall be a resident of the City and shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the City Council.

PUBLIC WORKS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The purpose of the Public Works Advisory Committee is to serve in an advisory role regarding Public Works programs, including but not limited to, roads, parkways, planted medians, traffic control devices, traffic signal maintenance, and other public infrastructure obligations of the City; assist staff to develop a tree planting/maintenance policy; assist staff in reviewing refuse rates and recycling programs; recommend and prioritize capital improvement projects or any other significant projects as selected by Staff; and review and recommend clean energy, energy conservation, and environmental sustainability programs. Members of the Public Works Advisory Committee are appointed by the City Council. The Public Works Advisory Committee consists of five members.

A member of the Public Works Advisory Committee shall be a resident of the City and shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the City Council.
