



## **BEST OF JURUPA VALLEY BEAUTIFUL HOME AWARD PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

### **Overview of Program**

The Best of Jurupa Valley Beautiful Home Award Program recognizes community homeowners who have displayed exemplary efforts in beautifying and preserving their home. By acknowledging their dedication, the City aims to foster neighborhood pride and encourage similar preservation efforts throughout the community.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

In order to be eligible for the Best of Jurupa Valley Beautiful Home Award Program, the homeowner and property must meet the following parameters:

- Homeowner must be a resident of Jurupa Valley
- Homeowner being nominated must reside in the home being nominated as their primary residence
- Property must be a single-family residence
- The residence must be located within the City of Jurupa Valley
- Residence must be free of any open code violations
- Residence must be properly permitted at the time of nomination
- The homeowner must be nominated through the nomination process during the nomination period
- City employees and elected City officials are not eligible for nomination

## **Nomination Process**

Nominations of eligible homeowners can be made online via a nomination form that will be made available on the City of Jurupa Valley's Housing Division webpage. The nomination form will request general information and photos of the residence being nominated. The nomination period and closing date will be announced on the City Housing Division webpage and on City social media. Nominations will be separated by their City Council District.

## **Eligibility Review**

The Housing Division will review the nomination to determine whether they meet the program eligibility criteria. All eligible nominations will be separated into their City Council District and will be sent to the Planning Commission for critique.

## **Scoring and Selection**

Each Planning Commissioner can utilize a provided scoring rubric to help guide the selection process. The winning residence for each district, as selected by the planning commission, will be noted as the winner.

## **Award Process**

The winning property owners from each District will be invited to a future City Council meeting to be publicly recognized. If winners are unable to be reached, the next runner-up for the applicable district will be contacted to receive the award. Recipients will receive a certificate of recognition, a floral arrangement, and a commemorative yard sign.
