**RECEIVE A MID-YEAR PERFORMANCE UPDATE FROM THE  
FAMILY SERVICE ASSOCIATION AND PATH OF LIFE MINISTRIES,  
INC.**

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## RECOMMENDATION

- 1) That the Community Development Advisory Committee receive a report from City staff describing the disbursement of CDBG 2025-26 and CDBG Public Service Grants, and;
- 2) Receive a presentation regarding the performance of the Family Service Association in making progress towards the goals established by the Agreement for the Senior Nutrition Program, and;
- 3) Receive a presentation regarding the performance of Path of Life Ministries, Inc. in making progress towards the goals established by the Agreement for Homelessness Services.

## BACKGROUND

The City received a \$1,026,523.00 allocation of Community Development Block Grants funds for the 2025-26 program year. Approximately fifteen percent (15%) (\$147,000.00) of that total CDBG allocation was identified for Public Service Grant (PSG) funding. On March 13, 2025, the Community Development Advisory Committee (CDAC) finalized their PSG funding recommendations to the City Council. On April 3, 2025, the City Council approved awards to: Family Service Association to provide the senior meal program prepared at the Eddie D. Smith Senior Center for \$20,000 and Path of Life Ministries, Inc. (Path of Life) for the provision of homelessness response and prevention services for \$127,000.

#### ANALYSIS

To assist the CDAC in monitoring the performance of public service grant recipients, City staff have asked all awardees to prepare oral presentations for the January 13, 2026 meeting. The CDAC will have the opportunity to ask specific, performance-related questions of each PSG recipient.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

Public service grant allocations are derived from the City's CDBG 2025-26. No impact to the City's General Fund.
