Hello, I am Diana Pimentel and I have been a lifelong resident of Jurupa Valley, graduating from Jurupa Valley High School in 2021. My main comment and concern that I wish to be discussed is the current discretionary rezoning plan of the Santa Ana River Corridor for development. This proposed project is not only disheartening as a resident of Jurupa Valley, but also very frustrating as a Geology student who has extensive field experience in hydrology and water table contamination. This project would not only be irresponsible from an environmental perspective and cause habitat loss, but also for the actual development proposed for construction in the zone. The Santa Ana corridor, especially near Eastvale and Norco, is an important portion because of its identity as a groundwater aquifer recharge port. Jurupa Valley depends 100% on underground water for resident use. It is also there as a natural flood mitigation system that prevents damage to homes. Allowing the building of any development within the corridor would be nonsensical
