Good morning, Mrs. Louie and Mr. Berkson,

I hope this message finds you both well. I recognize that this request comes on short notice; however, I am writing to respectfully request that the City Council's February 19, 2026 vote on the Camino Terrace proposal be postponed.

We understand this represents the final scheduled opportunity for the City of Jurupa Valley to consider this matter. Since the last review, new objective information has emerged that we believe warrants careful consideration before a final decision is made.

Mrs. Louie,

You will be receiving a formal letter from the residents this week advising that:

1. A motion has been submitted to the Riverside County Fire Chief requesting a re-survey and reclassification of the Fire Hazard Severity Zone (FHSZ) applicable to the subject properties. Supporting documentation and objective evidence have been provided in support of this request.
2. A formal complaint has been filed with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in Washington, D.C. concerning the Housing Authority of the County of Riverside (HACR) and Wakeland Housing and Development Corporation. The complaint raises concerns related to public safety, construction code compliance, potential misuse of public funds, abuse of authority, and regulatory compliance.

Mr. Mayor,

In light of these pending matters—including the HUD review and the requested FHSZ reclassification for parcels 185-460-001, 185-470-001, and 185-470-002—we respectfully request confirmation by close of business on February 17, 2026 as to whether the Camino Terrace item will be removed from the February 19, 2026 City Council agenda. Proceeding under the current circumstances may materially affect the integrity of the decision-making process and the federal administrative record.
