Good Afternoon,

My name is Julia Davis. I received a Neighborhood Alert Poster on my door yesterday.

I have lived in the Neighborhood off of Limonite for ten years, my grandma has lived in the Neighborhood for the past 30 years.

We Do NOT Approve of the Housing project near Camino Real, Limonite, and Canyon Terrace Drive. On a typical afternoon, before the construction of From Limonite, down Clay Ave, to VanBuren Blvd. takes 25 to 45 minutes to drive less than a 3-mile stretch of road.

They built new storage units, which didn't cause more traffic. However, now they build housing complexes on both sides of Clay Ave without widening the street or adding lanes. Turning an already difficult street to drive even more dangerous, and inaccessible.

Let alone, I work at Jurupa and Fontana USD, and there is not enough space in the few schools nearby to accommodate two entirely new neighborhoods in an already highly populated area.

There should not be more housing construction; they should have re-done the roads before adding more infrastructure.
