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## FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING ON-STREET PERMIT PARKING IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD FROM MAY 1, 2019 TO OCTOBER 31, 2020.

This notice is to inform you that on April 6, 2017, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Jurupa Valley directed implementation of seasonal permit parking on the following streets:

Downey Street from Limonite Avenue to 64<sup>th</sup> Street  
Corey Street from Limonite Avenue to 64<sup>th</sup> Street  
Baker Street from 63<sup>rd</sup> Street to Kennedy Street  
Archer Street from 63<sup>rd</sup> Street to Kennedy Street  
63<sup>rd</sup> Street from Downey Street to Baker Street  
64<sup>th</sup> Street from Downey Street to Archer Street  
65<sup>th</sup> Street from Kennedy Street to Archer Street  
Kennedy Street from 64<sup>th</sup> Street to Archer Street

The goal of permit parking in your neighborhood is to mitigate on street parking concerns expressed by residents that may be associated with the seasonal use of the park area. The following items will be implemented prior to the Memorial Day weekend:

- Signs will be posted establishing permit parking for the area effective May 1 through October 31 annually.
- Bi-Annual permits will be available to residents online and through the attached application process.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted south side of 64<sup>th</sup> Street and the west side of Downey Street.
- Every **two years**, residents must apply for and receive new parking permit placards. Residents applying for permit parking in 2019 will receive a permit placard that will be valid until October 31, 2020.

Residents and property owners are encouraged to visit [www.JurupaValley.org/ParkingServices](http://www.JurupaValley.org/ParkingServices) to fill out an online application and receive parking placards in the mail as the most efficient method. Residents can also choose to fill out and mail in the attached paper application or visit City Hall during normal operating hours. City Hall is located at 8930 Limonite Avenue, Jurupa Valley, CA. City Hall is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Property owners that have active tenants are encouraged to make contact with their tenants immediately. Parking restrictions go into effect when signs are posted, which is scheduled to occur on May 1, 2019 of each year. This is the final notice.
